Best Practice – 1

1. Title:

"Young Entrepreneurship Breeding talent for Startups".

2. The Objective of the Practice:

Business has been confined to those who were in position of having resources in abundance. Post-liberation, it was open to all sections of the society. With the emergence of technological advancements young age people especially students, attained the confidence to explore more entrepreneurship using their innovative ideas. At SRDC, we took the initiative to launch the scheme of Young entrepreneurship; the purpose of this was to instill in our students the capability of leading their own ways of thinking.

3. The Context:

Majority of our students are worried about the uncertainties of making profit from a new business. To boost Morales we have designed few concepts that can help students learn more about the importance of business and also what makes entrepreneurship different from the traditional way of business.



Best Practice – 2

1. Title:

Freeships by the SRDC's Management for EBCs irrespective of Caste, Creed and Religion

2. The objective of the Practice:

Financial aid is provided to students that remit the whole or half of the institution's fees. Freeship is granted to needy students. It is also offered to outstanding sportsmen, provided students meet the requirements of the concerned authorities. To apply for Freeship, students are required to follow the eligibility terms and conditions of the College Management

3. The Context:

As an education institution, it is our primary objective to serve the Society. To help financially distressed parents who are unable to pay Fees are availed with freeship.

4. The Practice:

Those Parents who apply for freeship are availed with freeship ranging from 10% of the fees, and in some cases 75% & in rare cases even 100%.


The College Management has realized that parents are unable to pay fee due to the pandemic crisis in 2021-22. Accordingly, Management has passed a resolution to reduce the fees and revise the Fee Structure for A.Y. 2021-22.

Fees for B.Com, BAF, BMS, BFM was reduced by Rs. 2,000 and Fees for BSc-IT was reduced by Rs. 5,000
